1. I, the undersigned have read and understand, and freely and voluntarily enter into this Release and Hold Harmless Agreement with Cottonwood Creek Equestrian Center (Company), understanding that this Release and Hold Harmless Agreement is a waiver of any and all liability(ies).
2. I understand the potential dangers that I could incur in mounting, riding, walking, boarding, jumping, feeding said horse; including, but not limited to, any interactions with other horses. Understanding those risks I hereby release that Company, its officers, directors, shareholders, employees, sub-contractors, trainers and anyone else directly or indirectly connected with that Company from any liability whatsoever in the event of injury or damage of any nature (or perhaps even death) to me or anyone else caused by on incidental to me electing to mount and ride a horse owned or operated by Cottonwood Creek Equestrian Center.
3. I understand and recognize and warrant that this Release and Hold Harmless Agreement, is being voluntarily and intentionally signed and agreed to, and that in signing this Release and Hold Harmless Agreement I know and understand that this Release and Hold Harmless Agreement may further limit the liability of equine professionals to include any activity, whatsoever, involving an equine, including death, personal injury and/or damage to property.
4. I recognize and agree that I know which equine professional(s) I will be working with, and acknowledge that I agree said equine professional(s) has/have made reasonable and prudent efforts to determine my ability to engage in the equine activity, and has/have sufficient knowledge of my equine and horseback riding skills as to relieve, release and hold harmless said equine professional(s) from any continuing duty to monitor my equine activities.
5. I further voluntarily agree and warrant to Release and Hold Harmless this (these) equine professional(s) from any liability whatsoever, including, but not limited to, any incident caused by or related to said equine professional's(s') negligence, relating to injuries known, unknown, or otherwise not herein disclosed; including, but not limited to, injuries, death or property damage from: mounting; riding; dismounting; walking; grooming; feeding; use of horse barn; use of arena; round corral, playground, paddock, trails or horse ring, in any capacity; falling off horse whether horse is bucking, flipping, spooked; or my failure to understand any equine professional's directions relating to my riding or otherwise use and control, or lack thereof, of my horse or the horse I have been assigned to.

AGREEMENT FOR RELEASE AND HOLD HARMLESS AND RIGHT TO ENTER PREMISES AND PARTICIPATION IN TRAINING, CLINICS AND ACTIVITIES EXTREME WYLENE HORSEMANSHIP The undersigned acknowledges the inherent risk involved in riding and working around horses, which risks include bodily injury from using, riding and being in close proximity to horses among other risks, and further that both horse and rider can be injured in normal use or in competition and schooling. I have personally had the opportunity to review the premises located at 18550 Evergreen Rd., Cottonwood, CA. known as Cottonwood Creek Equestrian Center, and I have satisfied myself as to the condition of the premises and the design, structure and circumstances involved with the areas I would like to use. I acknowledge that I have no necessity to participate in this clinic and that there are other equine activities at other sites I can attend. In consideration for the privilege of riding and working around horses and/or being a spectator at the activities being held at the above described property and participating in a clinic (training program), the Undersigned does hereby agree to hold harmless and indemnify the owners, occupants, and the organizers of the activities on said property and further release them from any liability or responsibility for accident, damage, injury or illness to Undersigned or any horse owned by me or to any family member or spectator accompanying the Undersigned on said premises. Upon the assurance that I have personally satisfied myself of the conditions of the premises, that I am aware of the inherent dangers involved, and based upon the foregoing release, indemnification and my assumption of sole liability for myself, my property, and my guests. I request permission to participate in activities on said property. I wish to participate in the following Extreme Wylene Horsemanship activity: _____ I fully understand that riding, schooling, cross country horse back riding, and jumping are very dangerous activities. I fully understand that riding is a very dangerous activity with many inherent risks, including but not limited to: (i) the propensity of an equine to behave in dangerous ways which may result in injury to the rider, trainer, groom, handler or spectators, (ii) The inability to predict an equine's reaction to sound, movements, objects, persons or animals, and (iii) Hazards of surface and subsurface conditions and riding over unknown terrain where hazards may be hidden by vegetation or development. I wish to participate in these activities knowing they are dangerous. I accept and assume all risks of injury (including death) to me, or my property. In exchange for being permitted to participate in these activities, I do for myself, my heirs, guardian and legal representatives, release and agree not to make or bring any claim of any kind against the owners or occupants of the above described property, and its partners, officers, employees and agents or the persons making the property available to me for any injury (including death), to me or any damage to my property whether from anyone's negligence or not, or any other cause, arising out of my presence on the premises or my participation in these dangerous horse related activities. I also agree that if anyone makes any claims because of any injury to me (including death), or for any damage to my property, I will keep all these released by this agreement free of any damages or costs because of those claims. My signature hereby indicates I have been advised for safety to wear an ASTM approved riding helmet at all times while riding on the premises and I shall obey all rules of the event organizer.

Clinic Format:

What will you get when you come to Wylene's clinic you ask??

You will be getting personalized and group attention with focus on your goals. She is going to show you what you need in order to make the magic happen. What happens in most clinics is that you go and you learn what the clinician's program is however in this clinic you will learn what control exercises you are lacking to fulfill your goals. If you are wanting to learn how to get your horse to stand still for mounting then she is going to show you the cues that your horse needs or is not

listening to and then will work with you on getting that taught and finished. However if your goal is to do a flying lead change but you can't always pick up the correct lead then she is going to go through a series of loping exercises and shoulder control exercises that you need in order to be successful and by the end of the 3 days you will be able to not only get a flying lead change but understand all the mechanics. Clinic hours are 9am - 4 pm with a 1 hour lunch break. Her Clinics are all about how you can communicate effectively with your horse.

- How to gain better control on the trail
- How to handle the spooky horse in scary situations
- How to control your horses' head, shoulders and hips from the saddle and from the ground
- You'll learn all about leads and lead changes... including from a walk right into the lope
- You'll learn about your body position... how to ride more balanced and controlled
- Curbside
- The Emergency Stop

The State of California requires all horses entering the state to have a Negative Coggins within the last 12 months. This test takes some time, so if traveling from out of state, please plan ahead. Your horse should be healthy and in good shape.

Hay:

If you need to purchase hay, the local feed store, Shasta Feed 530-347-6033 has good quality Hay.
