2. I understand the potential dangers that I could incur in mounting, riding, walking, boarding, jumping, feeding said horse; including, but not limited to, any interactions with other horses. Understanding those risks I hereby release that Company, its officers, directors, shareholders, employees, sub-contractors, trainers and anyone else directly or indirectly connected with that Company from any liability whatsoever in the event of injury or damage of any nature (or perhaps even death) to me or anyone else caused by on incidental to me electing to mount and ride a horse owned or operated by Cottonwood Creek Equestrian Center.
3. **I understand the potential dangers at this time of possibly being exposed to the Coronavirus (COVID19) and certify that to the best of my knowledge, I have not been exposed to this virus in the last 30 days nor tested for the Virus or had the Coronavirus. I release and hold harmless, Cottonwood Creek Equestrian Center from any liability should I acquire the Coronavirus in the future. I voluntarily and freely acknowledge this with my signature below.**

I understand and recognize and warrant that this Release and Hold Harmless Agreement, is being voluntarily and intentionally signed and agreed to, and that in signing this Release and Hold Harmless Agreement I know and understand that this Release and Hold Harmless Agreement may further limit the liability of equine professionals to include any activity, whatsoever, involving an equine, including death, personal injury and/or damage to property.

I recognize and agree that I know which equine professional(s) I will be working with, and acknowledge that I agree said equine professional(s) has/have made reasonable and prudent efforts to determine my ability to engage in the equine activity, and has/have sufficient knowledge of my equine and horseback riding skills as to relieve, release and hold harmless said equine professional(s) from any continuing duty to monitor my equine activities.

Clinic Overview


-Mastering The foundation: Connection & Riding Excellence-

In any discipline, to be great you must first master the fundamentals and this course is full of them! Learn the benefits of having a program while maintaining the freedom & imagination to put the pieces together in a way that best helps our horse. This course is for both beginners and high level riders who want to fine tune their communication, raise their connection and advance their horsemanship.

- An application of the Jonathan Field Horsemanship Training Scale™ with Path, Speed, Bend & Balance
- Recognize how leadership & partnership work together to create a calm willing relationship with your horse.
- Discover how to "Stretch the elastic band" both emotionally and physically.
- Help your horse find relaxation in movement with the "active neutral sweet spot"

- Learn a circle program that develops a comfortable canter with bend & balance
- Develop maneuvers like: shoulders-in, lead departures, correct circles, leg yield, half pass
- Improve your lead departures & build a foundation for lead changes
- Develop your horse's self carriage for healthy biomechanics & long-term soundness

 **There's always a slight difference in the dynamic of each group of people and horses. Some lessons may be focused on more than others, including some not mentioned here. If one of these goals is important to you, please mention so at the beginning of the clinic.**

RIDERS under 18 MUST wear a helmet.

Cancellations:

Horses:

The State of California requires all horses entering the state to have a Negative Coggins within the last 12 months. This test takes some time, so if traveling from out of state, please plan ahead. Your horse should be healthy and in good shape – you will be in the saddle most of the day.

You should be able to walk, trot and canter comfortably on a loose rein.

Horsekeeping:

Please try to arrive before dark as it makes it easier to find your way around. The stalls are covered. If you need or want shavings they are available to purchase or you can bring your own. Bring a bucket and your feed.

You are responsible for cleaning your own stall daily and before you leave. If stalls are not clean upon departure you will be charged an additional \$25.00.

Hay:

If you need to purchase hay, the local feed store, Double D Feed 530-347-6033 has good quality Hay.

Directions to Cottonwood Creek Equestrian Center

Cottonwood is located between Redding & Red Bluff on Interstate 5. From I 5 Take Bowman Road exit. Go West on Bowman Rd. for 3 miles. Turn Right on Evergreen Road. Go 1 mile. We are on the right – Sign out front - you can see the covered arena from the road. DO NOT follow your GPS – it takes you to our neighbor's driveway. Look for our sign.
